“BCP” notation refers to the Book of Common Prayer 1979—the red book.  
“Hymn” refers to the Hymnal 1982—the blue book.

## THE WORD OF GOD

*On this day the ministers enter in silence. All then kneel for silent prayer, after which the Celebrant stands and begins the liturgy with the Collect of the Day.*

### THE COLLECT OF THE DAY

BCP, p. 276

Celebrant: Blessed be our God,

People: *For ever and ever. Amen.*

Celebrant: Let us pray.

Almighty God, we pray you graciously to behold this your family, for whom our Lord Jesus Christ was willing to be betrayed, and given into the hands of sinners, and to suffer death upon the cross; who now lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.

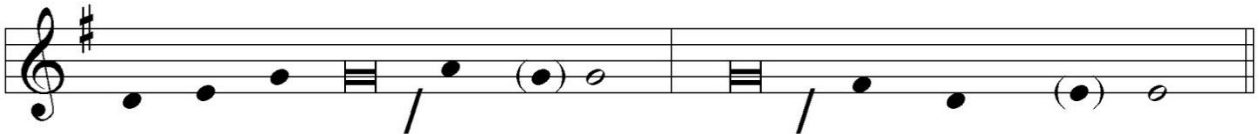
People: *Amen.*

### THE LESSONS & GRADUAL

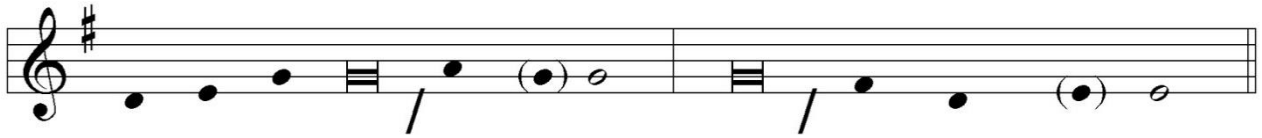
First Reading: *Isaiah 52:13—53:12*

*A period of silence is kept after the reading.*

Gradual: *Psalms 22*



- 1 My God, my God, why have you for-/ saken me? \*  
and are so far from my cry and from the words / of my distress?
- 2 O my God, I cry in the daytime, but you do not / answer; \*  
by night as well, but / I find no rest.
- 3 Yet you are the / Holy One, \*  
enthroned upon the praises / of Israel.
- 4 Our forefathers put their / trust in you; \*  
they trusted, and you / delivered them.
- 5 They cried out to you and were de-/ livered; \*  
they trusted in you and were / not put to shame.
- 6 But as for me, I am a worm and no / man, \*  
scorned by all and despised by / the people.
- 7 All who see me laugh me to / scorn; \*  
they curl their lips and wag their / heads, saying,



- 8 “He trusted in the LORD; let him de- / liver him; \*  
let him rescue him, if he / delights in him.”
- 9 Yet you are he who took me out of the / womb, \*  
and kept me safe upon / my mother’s breast.

you were my God when I was still in / my mother’s womb.
- 11 Be not far from me, for trouble is / near, \*  
and there / is none to help.


